



UCAS Timeline 2018/19



All pupils intending to apply for University for August 2019 or for deferred entry should already have registered on UCAS Apply. If you have not done so please see your House Head for a pack and register ASAP.

- **29th June** - LEAPS eligibility checked by all pupils. This can also be done at www.leapsonline.org – if you need help please contact your Head of House or you can contact LEAPS directly. ***Please note that if you have not already spoken to Mrs Pirie about this you must do this ASAP. The school cannot identify LEAPS eligible applicants, this must be done by the pupils. There is no guarantee of an interview if this has not been completed on time.***
- **23rd August** – UCAS reference sheets issued to pupils during PST
- **24th August** – LEAPS eligible pupils to have completed the LEAPS survey at www.leapssurvey.org. If you require help with this please contact your Head of House. ***This must be completed or your interview cannot take place.***
- **27th August** – (P6) What is LEAPS talk in the lecture theatre
- **w/c 27th August** - Personal Statement Supported Study 1 (3.35-4.35)
- **31st August** - 1st Draft of Personal Statement submitted to House Head or staff mentor for all applicants. This must be prepared ahead of the LEAPS interviews.
- **3rd September – 10th September** - LEAPS 1:1 interviews
- **4th September (9.30-11.30)** – UCAS Exhibition
- **w/c 10th September** - Personal Statement Supported Study 2 (3.35-4.35)
- **18th September** - UKCAT registration closed.
- **19th September** –
 - 2nd Draft of Personal Statement submitted to House Head for all early applicants.
 - All sections of application (other than personal statement) completed by all applicants.

- UCAS subject references to be completed by staff for Music at the Conservatoire, Medicine, Dentistry, Vet Medicine, Oxford & Cambridge.
- **24th September**
 - Final Draft of Personal Statement submitted to House Head for all early applicants.
 - 2nd Draft of Personal Statement submitted to House Head or staff mentor for all other applicants.
- **26th September (P5)** – SDS Presentation during PSE in the lecture theatre (half of S6)
- **28th September** – UCAS subject references to be completed by staff for all other courses
- **1st October** – Deadline for Applications for Music at the Conservatoire
- **w/c 1st October** - Personal Statement Supported Study 2 (3.35-4.35)
- **2nd October** – Deadline to take UKCAT
- **12th October** –Final Draft Personal Statement to House Head for all applicants.
- Applications for Medicine, Dentistry, Vet Medicine, Oxford & Cambridge sent by House Heads prior to official deadline of **15th October 2018**
- **26th October** - Approval of Final Drafts Personal Statements by House Head
- **2nd November** – Final UCAS Application should be paid and sent to House Head to be submitted when all checks and references are completed. Payment is by credit/debit card via UCAS Apply website. If you will have any difficulties with making payment by this date, please contact House Head.
- Applications sent by House Heads prior to official deadline of **15th January 2019**
- **4th March (P6)** – Post Application LEAPS catch up – all LEAPS pupils who attended 1:1 interviews to attend

LNAT Deadline
