PERSONAL SUPPORT TIME

- The first week of every month, on a Monday, S4, S5 & S6 will be asked to do the following during Personal Support Time:
 - Open their diary at today's date
 - On the left hand page write the names of the subjects they are studying
 - Tick the traffic light which indicates whether they feel they are:

Safely On Track to reach their aspirational target (Green)
Almost On Track to reach their aspirational target (Amber)
Not On Track to reach their aspirational target (Red)

- This should be a short task but if pupils are not sure, they can speak to their class teachers and make sure their diary is completed by the end of that week.
- If pupils are 'Red' or 'Amber' in any subject, they should be able to say what they need to do to get on track.
- Pupils may be asked by heads of department, house heads, assistant house heads, class teachers and/or senior staff, whether they feel they are on track and what they need to do next.
- We will also let parents know who will hopefully ask to see pupil diaries
