

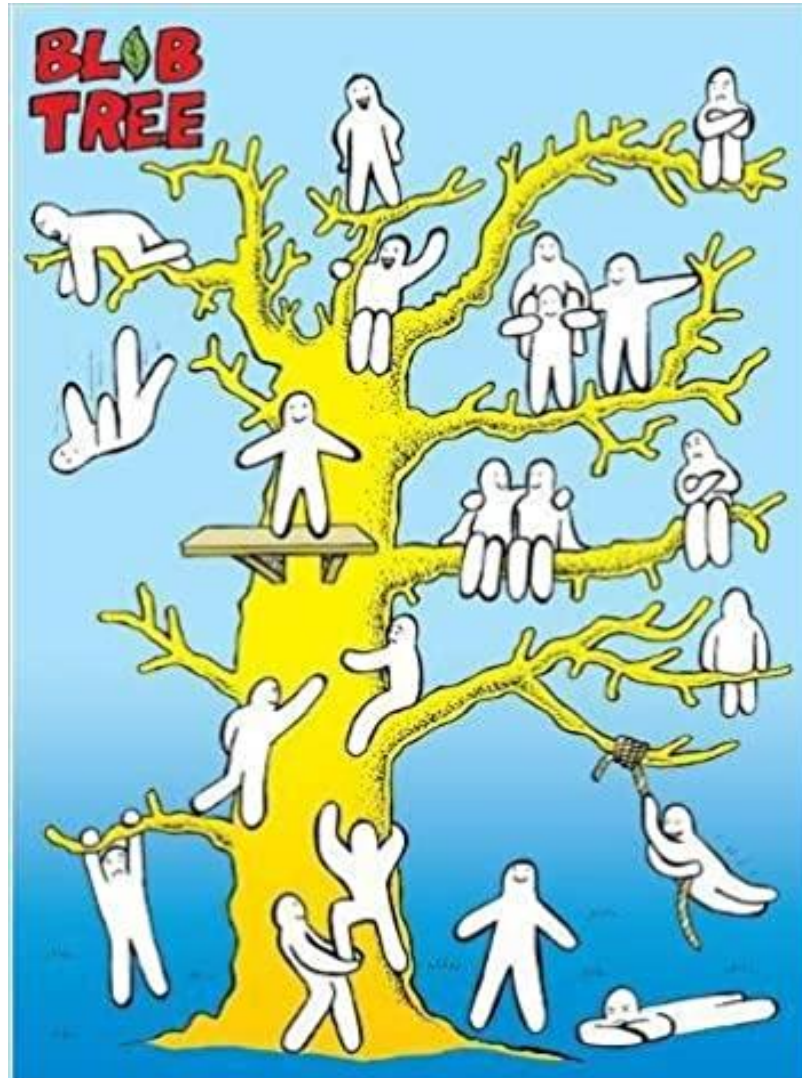

How are you feeling?

Getting ready – what will I need?

- Uniform

Uniform

- White school blouse/shirt and school tie.
- Black V-necked long sleeved jumper, cardigan or pullover with or without school logo.
- Smart black full length trousers.
- Black skirt (no shorter than mid-thigh).
- Plain black footwear.

Football tops.

Jeans or denim of any colour.

Visible t-shirts under shirts.

Strappy tops.

Cropped tops.

Sportswear trousers.

Coloured shirts.

Coloured “fluffy” boots.

Leggings or footless tights.

Shoes other than black.

Break is 10.25am – 10.40am. It lasts for 15 minutes. You can bring a snack from home or buy something from the canteen.

You can go outside at lunch time (as long as you remain within school grounds). There are also quiet spaces available to use.

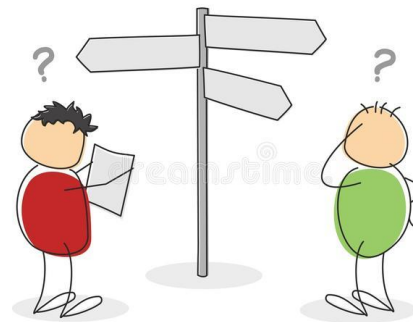


Finding my way around

Scenario	Answer
<p>I know where to go if I need help</p> 	<p>I can speak to my teacher or go to Pupil Support at break or lunch.</p> <p>I can complete a note that asks to meet with my House Head and hand this in to Pupil Support. My House Head will then meet with me.</p>
<p>I know what to do if I am late</p> 	<p>If I am late I go to the school office to sign in and then go straight to class.</p> <p>Try to be on time as you don't want to miss out or fall behind in your learning.</p>
<p>I know what to do if I feel ill</p> 	<p>If I feel ill I should tell my teacher who will allow me to go to Pupil Support.</p> <p>If at break or lunch I should go straight to Pupil Support.</p>
<p>I know how to find my friends during the day</p> 	<p>I should arrange with my friends where we will meet at break, lunch and at the end of the day if we are in the same classes.</p>
<p>I know what to do if I am going to be off school</p> 	<p>If I am going to be off school my parent/carer must call the school as early as possible to let them know.</p>
<p>I know what to do when I come back to school if I have been off</p> 	<p>If I have been off school I just go back to Pupil Support time to ensure I have been registered and then follow my normal timetable.</p>
