








How are you feeling?

- Black skirt (no shorter than midthigh).
- Plain black footwear.

Break and Lunch

Break is 10.25am – 10.40am. It lasts for 15 minutes. You can bring a snack from home or buy something from the canteen.

We currently have 2 lunch-times. S1-S3 have lunch from 12.20pm – 1.10pm. You can bring a packed lunch or buy something from the canteen. You can pre-order your lunch using an app or you can use your PIN number to purchase something from the counter. There are a variety of options available.

You can go outside at lunch time (as long as you remain within school grounds). There are also quiet spaces available to use.
