



# UCAS Timeline 2021/22



All pupils intending to apply for University for August 2022 or for deferred entry should already have registered on UCAS Apply. If you have not done so please register ASAP. More information can be found on SharePoint here - [UCAS 2021-22](#)

- **25<sup>th</sup> August** - All pupils considering university must have registered with UCAS apply.
- **27<sup>th</sup> August** - Online form completed to check LEAPS eligibility checked by all pupils at <http://bit.ly/LEAPS2021> *Please note that if you have not already spoken to Mrs Pirie about this you must do this ASAP. The school cannot identify LEAPS eligible applicants, this must be done by the pupils. Interviews are limited and once the LEAPS list is sent to the universities you will no longer be able to be added to this.*
- **3<sup>rd</sup> September** – LEAPS eligible pupils to have completed the LEAPS survey at [www.leapssurvey.org](http://www.leapssurvey.org). If you require help with this please contact your Head of House. *This must be completed or your interview cannot take place.*
- **17<sup>th</sup> September** – UCAS subject references to be completed by staff for Music at the Conservatoire, Medicine, Dentistry, Vet Medicine, Oxford & Cambridge.
- **22<sup>nd</sup> September** - UCAT registration closed (Medicine applicants)
- **29<sup>th</sup> September** - Deadline to take UCAT (Medicine applicants)
- **27<sup>th</sup> September – 6<sup>th</sup> October** - LEAPS 1:1 interviews
- **1<sup>st</sup> October** - Deadline for Applications for Music at the Conservatoire
- **15<sup>th</sup> October** – Official deadline for UCAS applications for Medicine, Dentistry, Vet Medicine, Oxford & Cambridge.
- **20<sup>th</sup> October** – UCAS subject references to be completed by staff for all other courses
- **15<sup>th</sup> November** - Approval of Final Drafts Personal Statements by House Head
- Applications sent by House Heads prior to official deadline of **26<sup>th</sup> January**

## PERSONAL STATEMENT TIMELINE - EARLY APPLICATIONS: MEDICINE, DENTISTRY, VET MEDICINE, OXFORD, CAMBRIDGE

For pupils applying to *Medicine, Dentistry, Vet Medicine and Oxford or Cambridge*, dates for submission of drafts of Personal Statements are as follows:

- **31<sup>st</sup> August** – 1<sup>st</sup> draft of Personal Statement to House Head
- **14<sup>th</sup> September** – 2<sup>nd</sup> draft of Personal Statement to House Head
- **25<sup>th</sup> September** – Final Draft Personal Statement to House Head
- **2<sup>nd</sup> October** – UCAS application to be paid and sent to House Head to allow checking and attaching references prior to 15<sup>th</sup> October deadline. Payment is by credit/debit card via UCAS Apply website. If you will have any difficulties with making payment by this date, please contact your House Head

## **PERSONAL STATEMENT TIMELINE– OTHER APPLICANTS (Except Conservatoire)**

For pupils **not** applying to *Medicine, Dentistry, Vet Medicine and Oxford or Cambridge*, dates for submission of drafts of Personal Statements are as follows:

- **17<sup>th</sup> September** – 1<sup>st</sup> draft of Personal Statement to House Head or personal statement mentor
- **8<sup>th</sup> October** – 2<sup>nd</sup> draft of Personal Statement to House Head or personal statement mentor
- **25<sup>th</sup> October** – Final Draft Personal Statement to House Head
- **20<sup>th</sup> November** – Final UCAS Application should be paid and sent to House Head to be submitted when all checks and references are completed. Payment is by credit/debit card via UCAS Apply website. If you will have any difficulties with making payment by this date, please contact your House Head

## **APPLYING TO THE CONSERVATOIRE**
