STUDY SUPPORT – TWILIGHT CLASS PROGRAMME

As a school we are committed to ensuring we support our students to achieve success in their qualifications - not only through every day learning and teaching but also through our annual supported study programme. We have put together a programme of twilight classes in a number of National 5, Higher and Advanced Higher subjects.

These twilight classes will be run by our own teaching staff and will revise and reinforce the course work covered in class and will give additional practice to exam type questions. Most will be face to face – some are highlighted as opportunities on Teams. Pupil focus groups suggested they would like to know the topics in advance for each session and also to have some opportunities for general supported study sessions. Our programme for this session outlines we have included both.

There will be no cost to the students for these classes. When a student signs up for a class they will be expected to attend each session. However, where there is a “clash” of subjects, students may alternate between subjects; or prioritise the subject where they require the most support. A register will be taken at every class. Please note, however, that classes may not run unless sufficient pupils sign up to a class.

The classes will commence the week beginning **Monday 1 November** and will run until **Thursday 2 December**. Prelims will run from Friday 14 January – Friday 28 January; more information to follow. The supported study programme will then resume from **Monday 31 January** and will run until **Thursday 31 March**.

For your son/daughter to take advantage of this additional help they need to **complete a short registration form which has been sent to their Glow email**. The links to the form is also below:

Forms should be completed by **Monday 1 November**. It will be possible for pupils to attend classes without completing the form if there is sufficient space.
