Break and Lunch

Break is 10.25am – 10.40am. It lasts for 15 minutes. You can bring a snack from home or buy something from the canteen.

Lunch-time is 1.10pm-1.55pm. You can bring a packed lunch or buy something from the canteen. You will be issued with a lunch card which can be topped up using the i-Pay system this will allow you to purchase your lunch in the canteen.

You can also pre-order your lunch using the Fusion App.

You can go outside at lunch time (as long as you remain within school grounds). There are also quiet spaces available to use.



Finding my way around

Your class teacher will share with you a virtual tour of our school and tours of different departments.

When you arrive in school in August, all S1 students will be taken to the lecture theatre where you will be given a warm welcome. There will be buddies to help you find your way for the first full week of S1. There are also signs on the wall to help you.
